What is Encore Ensembles?

Encore Ensembles is a division of Eighty Eight Notes School of Music in Falcon Heights. We provide instrumental music opportunities to private, charter, and homeschool locations.

How does the program work?

Your Encore teacher will be at your school one day per week. Upon signing up for band, your student would receive a 30-minute small group lesson and a 30-45-minute large group rehearsal. Your Encore teacher will work with the staff at your school to create a lesson schedule that fits the needs of the students.

What instruments do you offer?

For a band program we offer flute, clarinet, alto and tenor saxophone, trumpet, French horn, trombone, baritone, and percussion. For schools that offer orchestra programs, we offer violin, viola, and cello.

How much does it cost?

The cost per student is \$52 per month plus a one-time \$20 registration fee. Families pay Eighty Eight Notes School of Music directly for this service. This money goes toward paying your Encore teacher, administrative costs, and operating expenses for the program.
