Dear families,

About three weeks ago, I brought in fourteen eggs from the Carter Coop, laid by last year's chickens, and we began the exciting journey of incubating! This is my favorite project of the year because of the natural conversations and learning that happen as we marvel at how God has created life. The students are always full of wonderful questions—not only about chickens, but about other animals, and even about human life! Our discussions always point back to our amazing Creator.

This year, one student summed up God's creation perfectly. This student, who already has chickens at home, said, "I usually just look at my chickens and think, 'Huh, there's a chicken,' but now I can look at them and think, 'Wow, that chicken actually started out pretty amazing."

Isn't God's creation just like that—amazing?! Have you ever stopped to think about all that God has made and how He created everything exactly as it needs to be? It truly is incredible when you take a moment to admire it. And the best part? His creation includes YOU. He created each of us exactly as He intended, placed us exactly where we need to be for this moment, and loves us beyond measure.

When we study our chicks, we learn that their heart begins to beat on day two of life inside the egg. A tiny speck, without even limbs or feathers yet, already has a heartbeat. Now, our chicks are full of life! Out of our fourteen eggs, we had TEN successful hatchers!

Of course, once they hatch, we have to name them: Brownie, Potato Chip, Pineapple, Mellow Yellow, Yellow Mellow... just to name a few. We will enjoy our time with them, learning even more about God's creation while they stay in our classroom. Then, four of the chicks will join a third grader at his home with his current flock, while the rest will return to their mother hen and rooster at the Carter Coop.
