
- Nomination forms are now available in the front office. Students may nominate themselves or a classmate.

Who can run?

- Students in grades 3–8 are eligible to run for class representative.
- Students in grades 7–8 may also run for an executive office: President, Vice President, Secretary, or Treasurer.

Parents, we encourage you to talk with your child about this opportunity and support them if they feel compelled to run. SCHOOL SAFETY DRILLS

Students and staff will be participating in safety drills throughout the year, including fire drills, severe weather drills, and intruder drills. Fire drills and intruder drills have been scheduled to begin during the first few weeks of school.

St. John's utilizes ALICE as the proactive strategies used in the event of an intruder. ALICE is an acronym for ALERT, LOCKDOWN, INFORM, COUNTER, EVACUATE. Faculty and staff have been trained on ALICE via online classes and in-person training and drills. Students in grades Preschool - 8th grade will also be trained on these strategies as well. This training, however, will differ based on ageappropriateness. Intruder drills will include simple classroom drills as well as all-school drills. All intruder drills will be announced to students in advance, and students will always know that they are participating in a **practice** intruder drill. The goal of intruders drills will be for faculty and students to practice safely evacuating the building and/or locking down in a classroom. At no time during any drill will simulations be used.

NO TECH MORNINGS

Students, don't forget that no technology, including cell phones and Chromebooks, is allowed in the morning from 7-7:30am.
