Classic Bible Memory for Primary Grades

K.+ **Mark 10:45** - [Jesus said,] "The Son of Man came not to be served, but to serve, And to give His life as a ransom for many."

2 Corinthians 5:15 - He died for all, that those who live should live no longer for themselves, but for Him who died for them and rose again.

Small Catechism: Confession & Absolution

2nd gr+ *What sins should we confess?*
Before God we should plead guilty of all sins,
even those we are not aware of, as we do in the Lord's Prayer;
but before the pastor we should confess only those sins
which we know and feel in our hearts.

3rd gr+ *Which are these?*
Consider your place in life according to the Ten Commandments:
Are you a father, mother, son, daughter, husband, wife, or worker?
Have you been disobedient, unfaithful, or lazy?
Have you been hot-tempered, rude, or quarrelsome?
Have you hurt someone by your words or deeds?
Have you stolen, been negligent, wasted anything, or done any harm?

Recite - the Apostles' Creed and the Learn-by-Heart Bible Verse & Catechism

Read and Discuss - one of the Scripture readings from this past Sunday, from school, or the coming Sunday

Pray - the Lord's Prayer, Luther's morning or evening prayers, and the topical prayers for the day of the week

Sing a hymn - use one of the hymns from the past Sunday, the coming Sunday, or the school year

Benediction

L: Let us bless the Lord.

C: Thanks be to God.

L: The Lord bless us, defend us from all evil, and bring us to everlasting life.

C: Amen.
